Article 5 Use and Operation of the Transfer Station

1. Operating days and hours will be established by the Department of Public Works (DPW Director) and approved by the Board of Health and shall be posted at Town Hall, Truro Library and Transfer Station.
2. The DPW Director will take all necessary steps to ensure an effective level of facility operation and service.
3. The DPW Director or his/her designee may, at his/her discretion, close the Transfer Station when there is an equipment problem, or any other problem that makes the transfer of refuse not feasible, or that may result in a health hazard.
4. All materials accepted at the Transfer Station shall be placed in only those areas designated by the DPW Director or his/her designee.
5. All vehicles discharging refuse must stop at the gatehouse prior to unloading materials. Materials being brought into the Transfer Station for disposal are subject to inspection by the DPW Director and/or his/her designee.
- 6. Front loading, side loading or rear loading trash compacting trucks and roll off trucks are prohibited from unloading refuse at the Transfer Station.***
6. 7. Residential/Refuse Hauler Requirements for Use of Transfer Station/Recycling Center
 - a. All trash and recyclables must be generated from within the Town of Truro.
 - b. All loads must be properly secured and covered.
 - c. All recycables shall be separated and placed in designated receptacles.
 - d. All users must be:
 - Truro property owner or resident with a valid sticker;
 - ***Truro*** businesses with a valid refuse hauler permit from the Truro Board of Health;
 - Truro vehicles and/or vehicles under contract by the Town;
 - Seasonal rentor/visitor with a valid sticker
 - e. Resident and visitor stickers are good for household trash or recyclables only. Stickers are to be permanently affixed to the vehicle's bumper. The sticker holder is entitled to unlimited entry for disposal of reasonable quantities of ordinary household waste during normal business hours of operation.
7. ***8.*** All stickers allow for a maximum of four bags (32 gallon capacity or less) per entry.
